Minutes of the Annual Public Meeting held in the Village Hall at 7:45 pm on Monday 6th May, under the chairmanship of Mr J. Tasker:

Rimmer, Vicar of Marston) excluding committee members were present. Mr Tasker welcomed them.

Mr Jones gave a report on the use of the Hall and on the repairs carried out during the year. He said that it was hoped to start the extension to the Hall in April, 1969.
